Annual Lenten Challenge

Each year, Trinity Women challenge you to give up your Starbucks coffee, your extra large french fry, or a new shirt and donate the money you would have spent to one of the ELCA good gifts projects. This year we will be building latrines. When you gotta go, you gotta go. But 2.3 billion people lack access to basic sanitation. Without facilities, contamination of the local water supply and food chain make far too many people sick. A new latrine, along with training to help with maintenance and hygiene, leads to a healthier community and a safer way to "take care of business"! Trinity women will be collecting your donations with the hopes of building 3 latrines. Watch the bulletin board in the fellowship hall for our progress. Donations may be given to any Trinity Women member or included with your offering.

Mark the donation: Latrines.

The Organ Committee launched its pledge drive on Palm Sunday, April 14, 2019, with a goal of raising an additional \$75,100 toward the organ contract of \$131,710. This goal excludes estimated other costs of \$30,000 associated with the demolition and construction project. At February 29, 2020, \$81,908 in contributions had

been received for the new organ. There now have
been 15 pledges received with outstanding balances
totaling \$29,722. We are now 73% of the way toward

our fundraising goal. The receipt of pledges and other contributions since April 14th leaves a balance left to raise of \$20,080. An update to these amounts will be given at least monthly in the *Lamplighter*.
