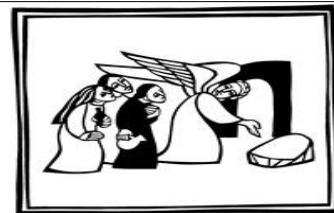

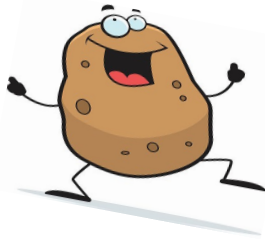
The work was **DONE** to repair the **FLAT** roof of our building. The total cost was \$6149.75
